- Allissa Christensen presented on behalf of the Town of Whitehall the "Let's Go Play Whitehall" park proposal to clear up questions that were asked in the past meeting.

- The location for the park does have some flexibility, however the horseshoe pit location was determined to be the best spot for the park, a public forum will be planned to discuss with the community.

- Allissa is requesting 30k for the Whitehall Tax Increment Foundation for matching later today. Successfully received 20k from the Dennis and Phyllis Washington Foundation and could receive another 20k next year if it is matched, with an addition of 10k from Town Pump. Currently requesting 35k from the Whitehall Sustainability Committee.

- Liz mentioned doing a story on the playground and getting it published in the Whitehall Ledger to begin getting the word out there to the community.

- The group that was present filled out the project evaluation form and turned them into the President and vice President for review, if passed they will submit a packet to Chuck B.
