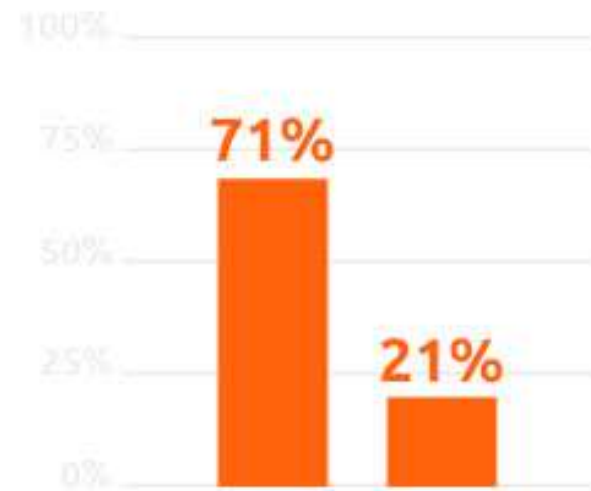



Funds Requested from other sources

Funding has been requested from Town Pump for \$25,000 (haven't received results yet)

Funding is being requested from the WTIF (Whitehall Tax Increment Fund) Board for \$25,000 (verbal approval, will get confirmation at their April meeting)

Funding has been requested from the Tony Robbins Foundation for \$10,000 (haven't received results yet)

Funding has been approved for \$20,000 from the Dennis and Phyllis Washington Foundation. An additional \$20,000 will be awarded in 2023 if the Town can match.

Timeline & Info

My focus right now is to secure funding for this project.

Once funds are secured, I would like to get started as soon as possible.

Playcore can help from start to finish with design and installation.

The Town will maintain the equipment and provide insurance.
